If his offering be a burnt sacrifice of the herd, let him offer a male without blemish: he shall offer it of his own voluntary will at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the Lord. And he shall put his hand upon the head of the burnt offering; and it shall be accepted for him to make atonement for him. And he shall kill the bullock before the Lord: and the priests, Aaron's sons, shall bring the blood, and sprinkle the blood round about upon the altar that is by the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. And he shall flay the burnt offering, and cut it into his pieces. And the sons of Aaron the priest shall put fire upon the altar, and lay the wood in order upon the fire: And the priests, Aaron's sons, shall lay the parts, the head, and the fat, in order upon the wood that is on the fire which is upon the altar: But his inwards and his legs shall he wash in water: and the priest shall burn all on the altar, to be a burnt sacrifice, an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the Lord. Spiritual Application for Worshipers Today

a. God Deserves Our Best

• Like Israel, believers today are called to bring **wholehearted worship**, not leftovers or half-measures.

b. Sincerity Over Ritual

• "Without blemish" is not about outward polish, but about offering God what is genuine, pure, and true.

c. Christ Our Righteousness

- While God demands "without blemish," only Christ can ultimately meet the standard.
- Through Him, our offerings are made acceptable (Heb. 10:14; Eph. 5:2).


